
Steve also ran through new Items from Jimmyjane for us. The Intimate Care Menstrual Cups come packaged with two capacities, and the Kegel Trainer set also features a pair of products, to best suit the user's changing needs. Offering a bit more zip, the Jimmyjane Focus Sonic Vibrator is a bulb-shaped vibe, with an ultra-high-speed fine tip for pinpoint delivery of power. Another great product. Not least because it also ships with three interchangeable softer tips to fine-tune the user experience.

Her Pocket Bullet and Her Rechargeable Bullet are what you'd imagine, while Her Personal Sex Machine is a handsome thruster. Her Finger Vibe – also in the Fantasy for Her range – is another product whose name needs little explanation. Highly controllable though,

Three Ultimate Rabbits, Fuck Me Silly To Go compact masturbators and Control, a hair-product-disguised masturbator from Sir Richard's rounded off a really informative presentation.

'When the music stopped' we all shuffled clockwise again, which brought the group to Shunga and Manon Vallee. Unusually for the company best known for massage oils and



bathtime sensual soothing, Shunga has introduced a toy to its portfolio; a 10-speed bullet which comes with three sensation gels and a lube as a kit. A pair of intensifying creams – red and blue/warming and cooling – followed, along with the Rain of Love G-spot arousal cream and Sensual Body Powder, which I'd been dusted with at the ETO Show the previous month.

"Vegan, organic, odourless..." Manon's wellpracticed pitch dashed along. "Organica, Dead Sea Salt, aromatic, candles..." I was more focused on Shunga's always beautiful packaging.

Love Bath, which comes in three varieties, was Manon's final focus and she talked us through how it turns from crystals to an erotic goo in warm water. The packs also come with a dispersal product, which allows the bathwater to turn back to a less glutinous liquid for easy disposal down the plughole.

Dream Toys was next. Or rather, Wendy Wang gave us 'Part 1 of 2' as there was too much to cover in half an hour. Much of her slot was dedicated to the range's new packaging, which has shrunk the logo to draw more
